What is SelectHealth?

SelectHealth is a specialized Medicaid plan from VNSNY CHOICE. It covers a wide range of services. This includes:

- Medical services
- Hospital services
- Vision care
- Prescription drugs
- Dental care
- Behavioral health care, such as mental health and substance use treatment
- Social support to help you receive community services
- And more.

Who Can Join SelectHealth?

SelectHealth is for:

- People living with HIV; or
- Individuals of transgender experience or gender non-conforming, no matter their HIV status; or
- Homeless individuals, no matter their HIV status.

Your dependent children can also join the plan with you.

To join, you must live in the Bronx, Manhattan, Brooklyn, Queens or Westchester and Nassau counties.

Why Choose SelectHealth?

SelectHealth provides easy access to the healthcare you need. This includes specialists in HIV and transgender healthcare at hospitals, clinics, private practices, and more.

Our plan also includes specialists in other types of medicine. This includes:

- **Cardiology** (treating heart and blood vessel conditions or diseases)

- **Dermatology** (the treatment of skin, hair, and nail conditions or diseases)
- **Pulmonary medicine** (the treatment of lung disease)
- **Endocrinology** (the treatment of hormone problems and related diseases, such as diabetes)
- And more.

Receive Tailored Services

With SelectHealth you have your own care team. You can count on these experts to know you *and* your healthcare needs.

Your care team includes:

- **Your primary care provider.** This is the doctor or nurse practitioner that you have chosen in the SelectHealth network. This person will help organize your medical care and treatment. If you are living with HIV, your primary care provider is an HIV Specialist.
- **A care manager.** This person coordinates support services that are important to you and your family.
- **A team of other caring professionals.** Your primary care provider and care manager will work with other staff to help you get the care you need, when you need it.





SelectHealth was created by New Yorkers for New Yorkers. We are dedicated to serving people with complex health needs so they can live well in their communities.

Other Important Reasons to Consider SelectHealth

For People Living with HIV:

- Your primary care provider is an HIV Specialist.
- Your care is led by people committed to serving the HIV community.
- HIV prescriptions are pre-approved, so you will not have to wait for prior authorizations.
- You have access to dedicated SelectHealth pharmacists. These individuals can work with you, your healthcare provider and pharmacy to help you stay on your medications (otherwise known as *medication adherence*).
- Nearly 6 out of 7 SelectHealth members have achieved complete viral load suppression. *Viral load suppression* is when HIV medicine reduces the amount of HIV in the

body to a very low level; this helps the immune system work better and prevent illness. SelectHealth has the best viral load suppression rate among other HIV Special Needs Plans in New York.*

For Individuals of Transgender Experience or Gender Non-Conforming:

- You have access to gender-affirming health providers (doctors, nurses, physician assistants, etc.).
- Expert providers welcome all members, no matter their gender identity, gender expression, or sexual orientation.
- Your plan includes hormone therapy.
- You have access to gender-affirming surgeries and care after surgeries.

- You can receive laser hair removal.
- You can connect with dedicated SelectHealth pharmacists who can provide transgender-specific adherence support.
- You have access to an outstanding network that includes:
 - The Mount Sinai Health System, including the Center for Transgender Medicine and Surgery and NYU Langone.
 - Community Health Centers, including Callen-Lorde Community Healthcare Network, Apicha Community Health Center**, and more.

For Homeless Individuals:

- You have a care manager who coordinates a personal care plan.
- You have access to support services.

SelectHealth is More Than You Think

When you join SelectHealth, you have access to the people, places, and services you need.

Healthcare Team

- Physicians
- Dentists and dental hygienists
- Behavioral health providers (mental health, substance use, and treatment providers)
- Dedicated SelectHealth pharmacists who can provide treatment adherence services

Healthcare Locations

- Community Health Centers (CHCs)
- Hospitals, including Designated AIDS Centers (DACs)
- Health Homes (a group of healthcare and service providers working together to get you the care and services you need to stay healthy)
- Home health agencies
- Community-based organizations (CBOs)
- Pharmacies
- Laboratories

Healthcare Services

- Medical care, including doctor visits, physical exams, lab tests, and referrals to our medical specialists
- Hospital care and emergency room (ER) services
- Prescription drugs*** and certain over-the-counter drugs
- Hormone therapy
- Telehealth services
- Gender-affirming surgery and care after surgeries
- Vision care and eyeglasses
- Dental care including dental exams, cleanings, basic restorative services and dentures

***Co-pays may apply for prescription drugs.





- Behavioral health care (mental health, substance use treatment)
- In-home personal care services
- HIV prevention and risk-reduction education
- Maternity care (Newborns of a parent enrolled in SelectHealth will automatically be enrolled in the same plan. The parent may remove the infant from the plan at any time.)
- Support services

You will still need your **Medicaid Benefit Card** for services like non-emergency transportation that are not covered by the plan but are covered by regular Medicaid.

Home and Community-Based Services

Qualified members have access to a range of services in their home or community to help them get and stay healthy as well as help with their recovery.

These services can help you:

- Live independently
- Return to school
- Find a job
- Get help from people who are in recovery
- Manage stress
- Prevent mental health and substance use crises

Ready to Join SelectHealth?

If you qualify for Medicaid through the New York State of Health (NYSoH) Marketplace:

You can join SelectHealth yourself. It's as easy as 1-2-3:

- 1) Sign into your online account.
- 2) Find VNSNY CHOICE on the plan selection page.
- 3) Pick SelectHealth.

If you prefer to join by phone:

- 2) Tell the counselor you want to join SelectHealth from VNSNY CHOICE. Counselors can help you in all languages.
